Toilet facilities are located at the main entrance of the building and at the end of the passage of the office block.



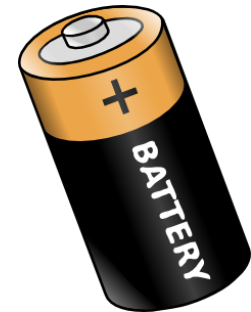
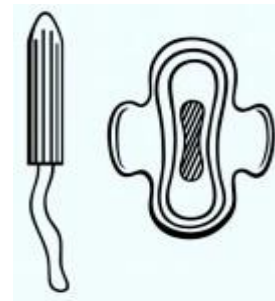
At Hartrao we make use of a septic tank sewerage system. Please don't dispose of anything that is not biodegradable in the toilet.



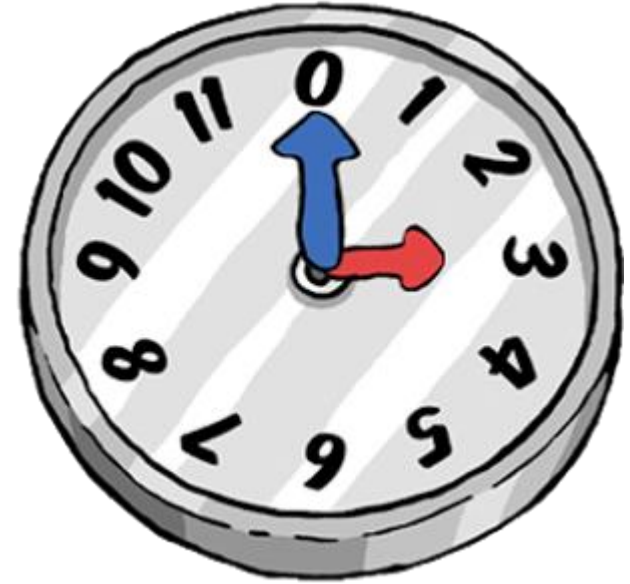
Items like the ones here should not be flushed down the toilet!

CLIMBING THE ANTENNAS 26m, 15m and 7.6m

Visitors may only go up on the antennas when accompanied by an authorized HartRAO staff member. Visitors must comply with the safety regulations for going on the antennas.

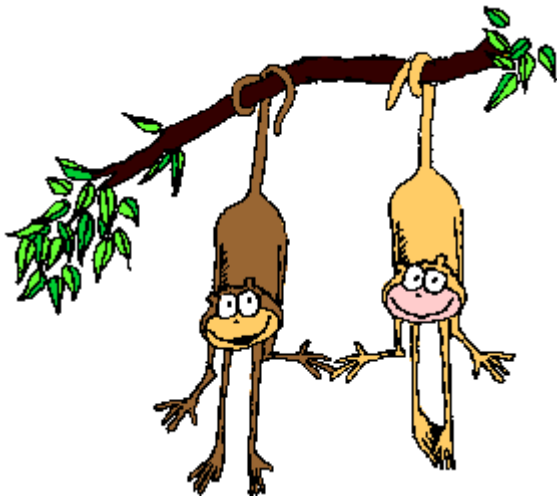
